

FOX RUN SEASONAL CLUB WALK & LITTER CLEAN-UP



A fellowship walk, which is open to the public, and litter clean-up of the Falcon Wanderers Fox Run Seasonal trail will be held on Saturday, July 1, at 9:30 a.m. All registration materials and the event stamp will be available at the trailhead, NOT the registration point

Participants can choose either the 5 K or 10 K distance, and the format will be a guided group experience. The trails are rated 2C,

consisting of natural materials and county roads, featuring rolling terrain at an altitude of 7,300 feet. Wheelchairs and non-jogging strollers cannot complete the course. Leashed pets are welcome. Owners are required to clean-up after their own pets. Restrooms are available at the trailhead, in the parking lot near the main entrance, and at the trailhead at the west entrance to the Fallen Timbers Wilderness Area.

The Falcon Wanderers Volksmarch Club has adopted the Fallen Timbers Wilderness trails, and this walk will be our annual litter clean-up. Bring any necessary tools to help in this effort.

DIRECTIONS TO FOX RUN TRAILHEAD:

From I-25 take exit 156 and turn east onto North Gate Boulevard. Follow North Gate Boulevard east approximately 2.6 miles to Roller Coaster Road and turn left (north). Continue approximately 2.3 miles to the parking area and trailhead on the left. If you reach Baptist Road, you've gone too far.
