DISTANCES: 6 Kilometers (3.7 miles) and 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

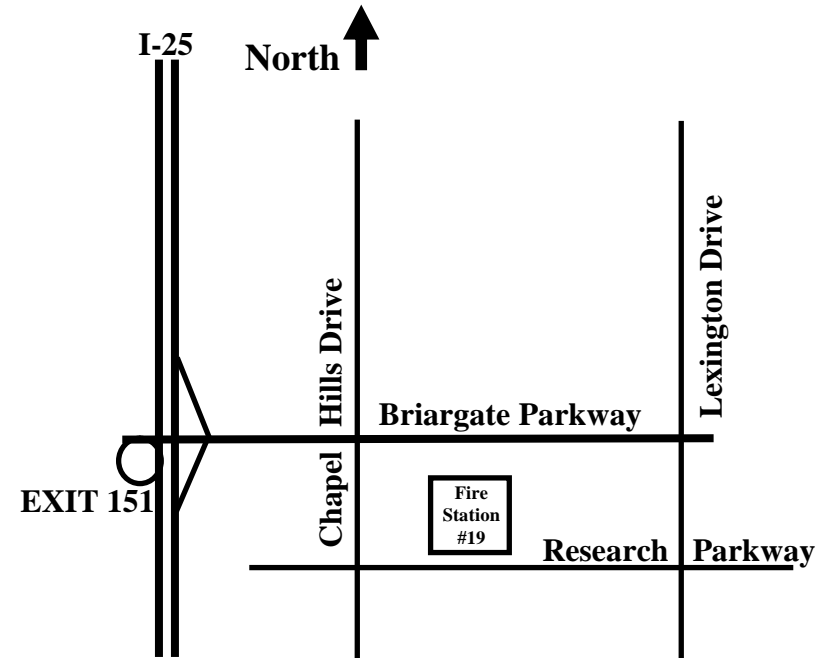

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The 6k and 10k trails are mostly cement paths and sidewalks, and established dirt trails through residential areas of northern Colorado Springs. The trails are rated 1B. Jogging strollers can complete these trails. Restrooms are available at the start/finish and at the 3k checkpoint in the park. Leashed pets are welcome on the trail. **PLEASE, NO PETS INSIDE THE FIRE STATION COMMUNITY ROOM.**

AWARD: No award, this is an IVV Credit Only walk.

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

WATER: Water available at the start/finish and manned checkpoints. Carrying water is highly recommended.



DIRECTIONS: From I-25, take exit 151, and proceed east on Briargate Parkway for 2 miles to Lexington Drive. Turn right onto Lexington Drive and proceed .9 miles to Research Parkway. Turn right onto Research Parkway and proceed .7 miles to the Fire Station (on your right) at 2490 Research Parkway. There is limited parking in the Fire Station Lot, but plenty of parking next door (west) at the businesses that are closed on Saturdays.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Walking the USA, A-Z; Walking the United States (50 States / 51 Capitals), Doin' the Louisiana Purchase, Take a Walk in a City Park, Points of Reference. During the walk, if you identify any item or element that fits the requirements for additional programs, please provide us with your special program book and we will stamp it.

NEW WALKER PACKETS: As an added incentive to participate in the volkssporting achievement awards program, new walker packets will be available. These packets allow the walkers new to the sport a "running" start at a reduced rate.
