THIS EVENT IS FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

START/FINISH: FamCamp Picnic Area #2, USAFA, CO 80840.

WHEN: Saturday, May 4, 2019

START: 9:30am - 12:00noon **FINISH:** By 3:00pm

Note: Public access to the Academy starts at 9:00am through the North Gate Entrance only.

DISTANCE: 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles) and 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

REGISTRATION FEES: This is an IVV credit only walk. All registrations will be handled at the event. The fee for IVV credit is \$3.00. Registration is free if no IVV credit is desired. Make check or money order payable to "USAFA Outdoor Recreation Center".

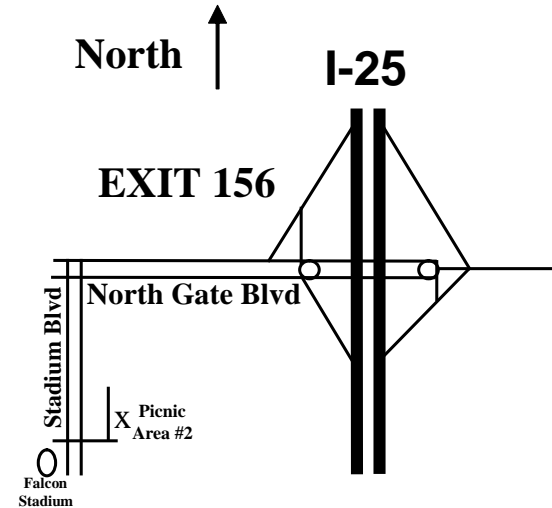

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail is mostly dirt trails, roadsides, and service roads. The 5km is rated a 1B due to uneven terrain and the 10km is rated a 3B. Strollers can complete the 5K trail. Wheelchairs cannot complete this event. Leashed pets only! Pet owners will pick up after their animal. Restrooms are available at the start/finish.

AWARD: There is no award for this event. It is IVV credit only.

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

WATER/FOOD: Water will be available at the start/finish and checkpoints. Carrying water is highly recommended. Food will be available for purchase at family prices.



DIRECTIONS: Visitors please use only the Air Force Academy's NORTH gate entrance after 9:00 a.m. Adults entering the Academy must have a valid picture I.D. with valid vehicle registration and proof of insurance. From I-25, take Exit 156. Go West on North Gate Blvd to the Academy's North gate entrance. The picnic area is two miles from here. Proceed up the hill to Stadium Blvd (B-52 aircraft on your left). Turn left (South) onto Stadium Blvd. Continue past the intersection of Parade Loop to Academy Dr and turn left (East) into the picnic area entrance and turn at first left (North) to Picnic Area #2. Follow signs/guides to parking.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Seat belts are required on the Air Force Academy.
2. Keep to the posted speed limits.
3. Watch out for joggers, bikers, deer, and other animals.
4. Have at least 1/4 tank of gas. No public service stations.
5. Smoking prohibited on the trail.
6. Do not use hand held cell phones while driving.

SPECIALTY PROGRAMS: Bridges - Spanning the USA, Walking the United States (50 States/51 Capitals); Walking the USA, A-Z; Doin' the Louisiana Purchase; Walking the Path of Inventions; Points of Reference.
