START/FINISH: Top of the Amphitheater, Florissant Fossil Beds National Monument Visitors Center, 15807 Teller County Road 1, Florissant, CO 80816.

WHEN: Saturday, September 14, 2019

START: 9:30 - 12:00 a.m. **FINISH:** By 3:00 p.m.

DISTANCES: 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles) and 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

REGISTRATION FEES: Event registrations will be handled on the day of the event. The fee for IVV credit is \$3.00. Registration is free if no IVV credit is desired. Make check or money order payable to “Falcon Wanderers”.

FLORISSANT FOSSIL BEDS NATIONAL MONUMENT ENTRANCE

FEES: These fees are collected at the Visitors Center on the day of the event.

- \$10.00 per adult (16 years or older). Good for 7 days.
- Anyone 15 years or younger is free.
- Interagency Passes are accepted.
- Florissant Fossil Beds Annual Pass - \$35. Good for cardholder and 3 other adults.
- The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Pass. Good for cardholder and 3 other adults.

**** MONUMENT RESTRICTIONS:****

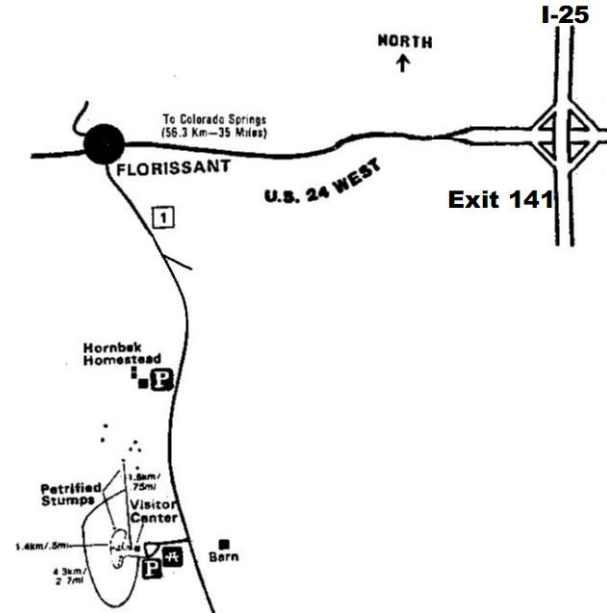
1. Pets are prohibited in the Visitor Center and on the trails. This is for the safety of the wildlife as well as for the safety of your pets.

DIRECTIONS: From I-25, take exit 141 (US Hwy 24 West), and proceed west 35 miles to the town of Florissant. Turn LEFT (south) on Teller County Road 1 and follow for two miles to the Visitor Center.



AWARD: This is an IVV Credit Only walk. “B” awards will be available for purchase for \$1.00 apiece.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: These walks will be on established dirt and gravel trails. The 5K is rated 2B and the 10K is rated 3B, due to the altitude. Jogging strollers can complete these trails, with difficulty. Wheelchairs can not complete this event. Restrooms are available at the start/finish. **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED.**

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

WATER: Water available at the start/finish. Carrying water is highly recommended.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Walking the USA, A-Z; Walking the United States (50 States / 51 Capitals), Doin' the Louisiana Purchase, and National Park Centennial. During the walk, if you identify any item or element that fits the requirements for additional programs, please provide us with your special program book and we will stamp it.

NEW WALKER PACKETS: As an added incentive to participate in the volkssporting achievement awards program, new walker packets will be available. These packets allow the walkers new to the sport a “running” start at a reduced rate.
