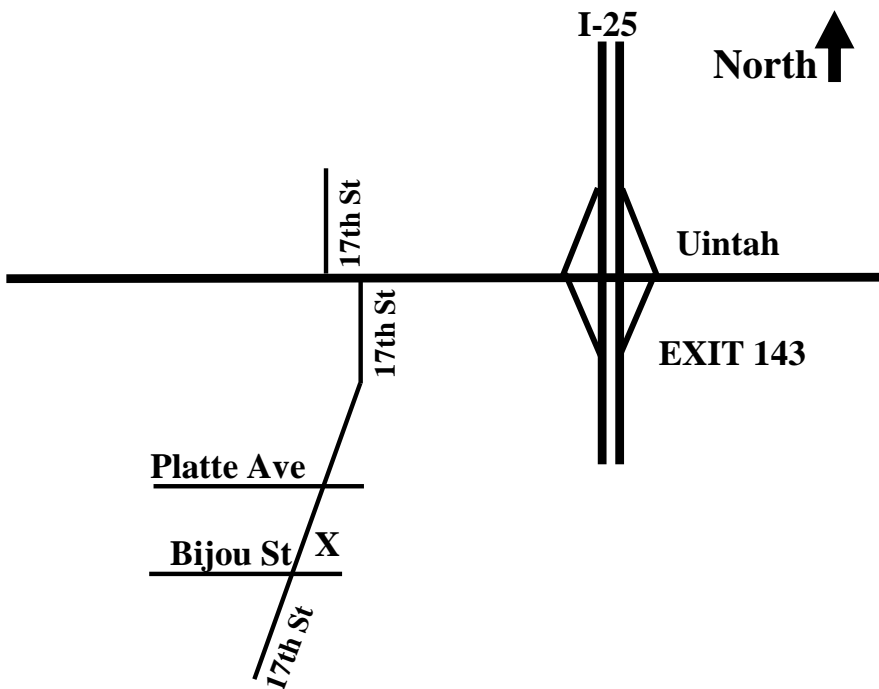

**DISTANCE:** 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles) and 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

**REGISTRATION FEES:** Preregistration fee is \$8.00 for the award and IVV credit, and must be received by November 30, 2019. Day of the event and late registration is \$9.00. **TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** The 5 & 10K routes will be on city streets & sidewalks. The routes are rated 1A, due to some hills. Strollers can complete the courses. Wheelchairs are discouraged due to deteriorated sidewalks and the lack of curb cuts. Leashed pets are welcome on the trail. Restrooms are available at the start/finish. **PLEASE, NO PETS INSIDE THE COMMUNITY CENTER!**

**AWARD:** A 3-4 inch diameter embroidered patch like the picture on the front cover of the brochure.

**IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS:** This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

**DIRECTIONS:** From I-25, take the Uintah Street Exit #143. Head west for 0.7 miles. Turn left onto 17<sup>th</sup> Street (before the 'Gas and Grass' station). The Center will be on your left on the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and West Bijou Street. There is a large parking lot available. Look for the large signs that say "Main Office".

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** This event qualifies for Walking the United States (50 States/51 Capitals), Walking the USA, A-Z, Doin' the Louisiana Purchase, United States Post Offices, Take A Walk In A City Park, Bridges – Spanning the USA, Points of Reference, and Animal Safari.

**NEW WALKER PACKETS:** As an added incentive to participate in the volkssporting achievement awards program, new walker packets will be available. These packets allow the walkers new to the sport a "running" start at a reduced rate.
