START/FINISH: Modern Woodmen of America, 2924 N. Beacon Street, Colorado Springs, CO 80907. The start/finish will be in the lower level at the back of the building. Walk down the driveway to the rear of the Modern Woodmen Building.

WHEN: Saturday, March 14, 2020

START: 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. **FINISH:** By 3:00 p.m.

DISTANCES: 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles) / 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

REGISTRATION FEES: This is an IVV credit only walk. The pre-registration fee is the same as the registration fee on the day of the event. Therefore, all registrations will be handled at the event. The fee for IVV credit is \$3.00. Registration is free if no IVV credit is desired. Make check or money order payable to "Falcon Wanderers".

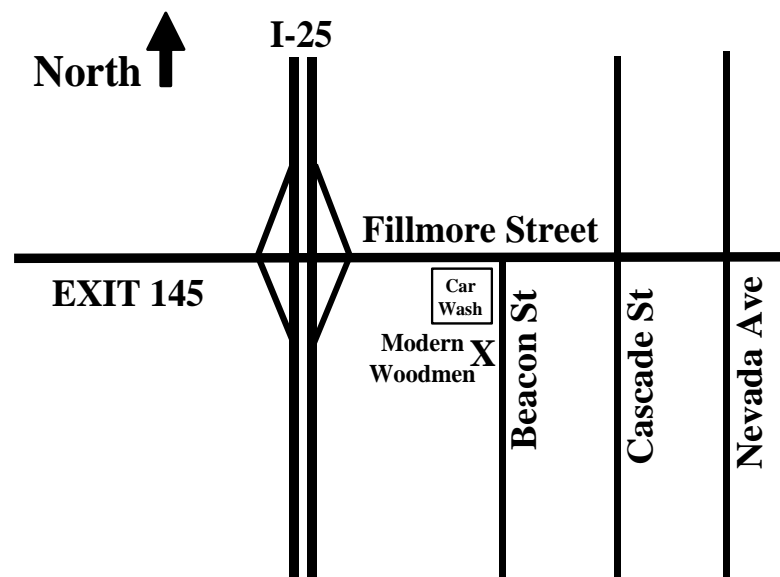

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail begins in Roswell, an old railroad stop. The walk will include part of the Rock Island railroad pathway, greenway paths, trails, and historic streets. The first checkpoint on both trails is the **Pikes Peak Trolley Museum and Restoration Shop**. Please see more information on touring the Trolley Museum within this brochure. The trails are rated 1B. Strollers can complete the course. Wheelchairs are not advised. Restrooms are available at the start/finish. Bring your favorite walking companion, whether 4 legged or 2 legged. Pets must be leashed! **Please, No Pets Inside The Start/Finish Building.**

TROLLEY MUSEUM INFORMATION: The Trolley Museum opens at 9:30 a.m. with the day's last tour at 3:00 p.m. The entrance fee includes a short ride on a restored trolley car. Entrance fees are: \$5.00 for adults, \$4.00 for seniors, & \$3.00 for children (12 & under). This museum and restoration shop is a not for profit 501 (c)(3) dedicated to preserving the rich history of trains and trolley cars in the Pikes Peak region. DIRECTIONS: From I-25, take Exit 145 (Fillmore St), & turn east onto Fillmore. Proceed to Beacon St (approximately ½ mile) & turn right (south) on Beacon. The Modern Woodmen Building is the start point. It is the building next to the car wash. Parking is limited to 18 vehicles behind the building. Additional parking is available in front, on the street, & in the lot south of the Modern Woodmen Building.

AWARD: IVV credit only. 'B' awards available for purchase.

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

FOOD/WATER: Bring your favorite "green goodies" to share with all the Leprechauns for a day. Water will be available at the start/finish and manned checkpoints. Carrying water is highly recommended.
