WHEN: Saturday, June 18, 2022

START TIME: Individuals wishing to walk on their own may start anytime between 9:00 – 10:00am. Walk instructions will be available. 9:30 am will be the start time for those wishing to walk with the group. Please allow 15-20 minutes to complete registration and book stamping.

REGISTRATION FEES: Registration is available at the event only. IVV credit is \$3.00. Registration is free, if no IVV credit is desired. Checks or money orders are to be payable to the "Falcon Wanderers".

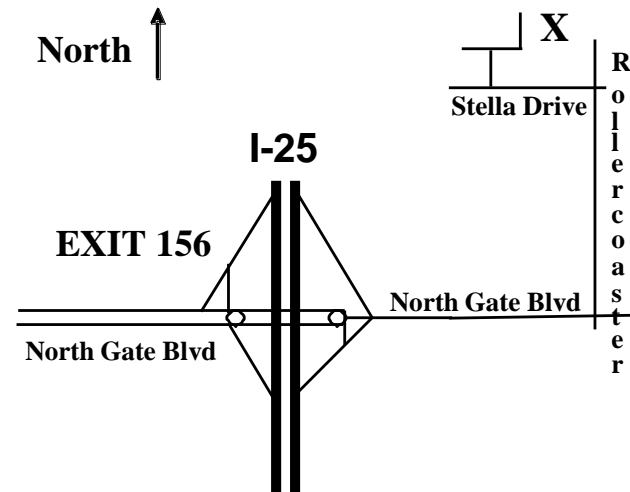
DISTANCES: 5 Kilometers (3.1 miles) and 10 Kilometers (6.2 miles)

AWARD: IVV credit \$3.00.

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

WATER: Carrying water is highly recommended.

TRAIL CLEANUP: We will conduct our annual trail cleanup to fulfill our responsibility as the trail sponsor. Please bring trash bags, grabber reacher tool, gloves, and any other supplies needed for this effort.



DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO START POINT: From I-25, take exit 156 (Air Force Academy/Gleneagle). Proceed east on North Gate Blvd about 2.7 miles to Roller Coaster Rd, and turn **LEFT** (north). Drive 2 miles to Stella Dr turn **LEFT** (west). Turn **RIGHT** (north) into Fox Run park entrance. Turn **RIGHT** and take drive straight ahead to parking lot & restrooms on your right.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The walk is on dirt trails and county roads and has been rated 2C, because of the hills and altitude (7,300 ft). The trail features undulating terrain with interpretive signs and some beautiful Pikes Peak viewpoints. Bring your camera. Large wheeled strollers can complete this event. Wheelchairs are not recommended. Leashed pets only! Restrooms are available at the trailhead. County: El Paso.
