START TIME: Individuals wishing to walk on their own may start anytime between 9:00 – 10:00am. Walk instructions will be available. 9:30 am will be the start time for those wishing to walk with the group. Please allow 15-20 minutes to complete registration and book stamping.

REGISTRATION FEES: Registration is available at the event only. IVV credit is \$3.00. "B" awards are \$1.00. Registration is free, if no IVV credit is desired. Checks or money orders are to be payable to the "Falcon Wanderers".

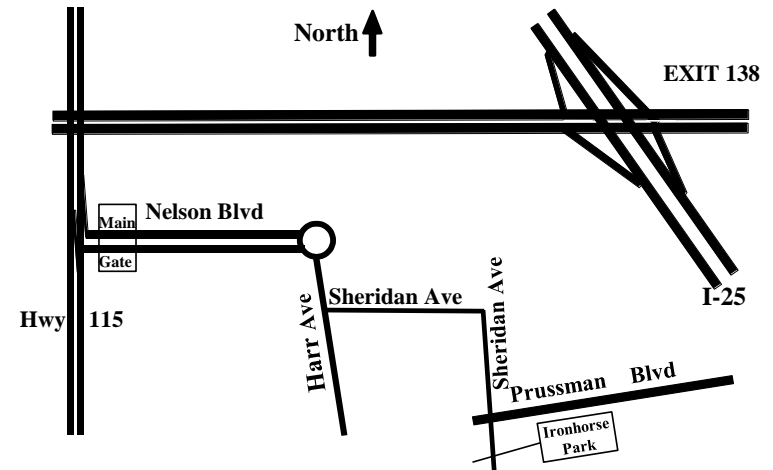

AWARD: IVV credit \$3.00; "B" award \$1.00.

IVV ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV achievement awards. Bring your books. Books will be available for purchase at the start/finish.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Walking with America's Veterans; Walking the USA, A-Z.

NEW WALKER PACKETS: As an added incentive to participate in the volkssporting achievement awards program, new walker packets will be available. These packets allow the walkers new to the sport a "running" start at a reduced rate.



DIRECTIONS: From I-25, take exit 138 and go west on Lake Ave. to the Hwy 115 inter-change. Turn left onto Hwy 115 and continue driving south on Highway 115 and follow the signs to Fort Carson's Gate #1 (Main Gate). All non-DoD participants must enter Fort Carson (Army Post) through Gate #1. As you approach the Army Post, get into the LEFT lane to turn into the Post. As you enter the Post, use the "All Visitors" lane to the RIGHT and go to the Visitor's Center. To gain entrance to the Post you must present your state driver's license and have your car registration and proof of insurance available. You will be asked to sign-in and will receive a 1-day MWR event pass to display on your car. All persons/vehicles entering the Post are subject to a random search. Once through the gate, stay to the RIGHT and bear right at the traffic circle onto Harr Avenue. At the first street (Sheridan Avenue), turn LEFT. Continue on Sheridan through the traffic light at Prussman Boulevard to Iron Horse Park on your left. Turn LEFT on 4th Infantry Division Road/Elwell St into the park and park in the parking lot.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail is the hard-packed dirt fitness trails and/or sidewalks of Fort Carson. Trail is rated 2B, due to altitude (5840 ft) and a few moderate hills. It is suitable for fitness walking/jogging strollers, but not wheelchairs. The trail circles the golf course and main post area. **Highly recommend** restroom stop before arrival at trailhead. Restrooms are available along the trail. Leashed pets are welcome. County: El Paso

WATER: Carrying water is highly recommended.

HIGHLY IMPORTANT, FORT CARSON ACCESS INFORMATION: All Non-DoD participants must enter Fort Carson through Gate #1. As you approach Gate #1, get into the left lane to turn into the post. As you enter the post, use the "All Visitors" lane to the right. To gain entrance to the post you must present your state driver's license and have your car registration and proof of insurance available. You will be asked to sign-in and will receive a 1-day MWR event pass to display on your car. All persons/vehicles entering the base are subject to random search.
